Required Materials:

Please mark all items with child's initials.

24 #2 lead pencils **Or** 4 click pencils with plenty of **extra** lead
2 **large** erasers (pink or white) no toys please
1 **clear** 12-inch ruler with **metric and standard**
1 pair of scissors
2 large glue sticks or 4 small glue sticks
1 crayon box, **24-count**, please no large ones
1 set colored pencils (24 or less)
2 **wide-ruled** composition books (100 pages) ^
(Please no college-ruled composition books)
1 drawing pad, **spiral** bound (9"x12") ^
3 folders for loose papers
Personal box of tissues as needed
1 water bottle
1 lunch box/sack (keep in backpack)
1 **backpack** to carry books, lunch, etc.
1 compass, 1 protractor (Grades 4-8)
Non-marring gym shoes

Items NOT to Bring:
